

**PGDM vs MBA** - Every aspirant has this comparison in mind before signing up for a management course. So, what is the difference between PGDM and MBA? Which one is better ?? Difference and Similarities between MBA and PGDM.

# 5 key differences between PGP(M)/PGDM and MBA

#### 1. PGDM vs MBA (Degree vs Diploma)

At the end of a **PGP and PGDM course**, the candidate is offered a **Diploma** whereas at the end of an **MBA programme**, the candidate receives a **Degree**.

Many students think that a Diploma course does not hold the same value as a Degree course but that is not true. Many Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) and other top B-Schools such as <u>XLRI, Jamshedpur</u> and <u>SP Jain Institute of Management and Research, Mumbai</u> offer PGP or PGDM courses. Most of these institutes are autonomous bodies (not affiliated to any University). Between a PGDM and an MBA, the <u>difference is of nomenclature but not of professional value</u>.

Both MBA and PGDM are highly valued in the job market as they are same in terms of course accreditation, curriculum and pedagogy. Another key factor is the institute. For example, a PGDM course from XLRI Jamshedpur will have more professional value than a degree course from a state university

#### 2.MBA vs PGDM: Syllabus

In most cases, the MBA course curriculum is designed by the university. The core MBA syllabus (and sometimes even elective subjects) will be pretty much the same in two MBA colleges under the same university. Even though the PGDM syllabus is no different from the MBA syllabus, since PGPM or PGDM courses are determined by the individual institute, it gives them certain flexibility to design the course curriculum. The MBA syllabus undergoes change according to industrial requirements periodically. Universities tend to lag behind and change their syllabus after a few years.







### 3.MBA vs PGDM: Susceptible to Fraudulence

Since PGP or PGDM courses are offered by autonomous bodies, students need to be careful while taking admission. Many smaller colleges and institutes make claims but do not have proper accreditation status. MBA degrees are conferred by varsities, and hence there's a lower chance of fraudulent claims. Management aspirants should look for genuine accreditations. **Apart from UGC recognition**, management institutes are accredited by **NAAC**, **AACSB**, **AMBA** and **Equis**.

#### 4. MBA vs PGDM: Focus Subjects

Both MBA and PGDM courses have common core subjects. However, some experts claim most MBA courses focus more on theoretical and technical aspects of management rather than adopting a practical approach. PGP or PGDM courses on the other hand, have an industrial orientation and focus on skills-based on market requirements.

#### 5. MBA vs PGDM: Cost

It has been observed that most MBA courses have lower tuition fees as compared to PGP or PGDM courses. This is so because MBA degree is offered mostly by government institutions. These universities receive financial aid and grants from the government, making the degree cheaper for the student. In case of a PGP or PGDM degree, students have to bear the cost of the entire programme as private universities that offer these degrees have no government backing. However, this is not an ironclad rule. There are institutes which charge high tuition fees like the IIMs. The IIMs have high MBA fees despite not-being a private institution. This is because, it is an autonomous institution not funded by the government However, the MHRD has some role to play in running the IIMs.



# **Difference between MBA and PGDM**

There are several other factors which make MBA and PGDM different entities.

# Admission Process of Top MBA Colleges in India other than the IIMs

Since there is no common counseling for admission to MBA colleges, candidates have to apply for every institute separately to secure an MBA seat.

In India, many colleges and universities offer MBA (Master of Business Administration) and PGDM (Post Graduate Diploma in Management programs under different admission categories, including the **Institutional Quota**. The Institutional Quota typically refers to seats reserved for certain categories of students, such as management quota or seats allocated by the institution for students who may not have cleared the entrance exam with high ranks but are willing to pay a higher fee. Here is an in-depth look at MBA/PGDM admissions under the **Institutional Quota** in India:

#### **Key Aspects of Institutional Quota in MBA/PGDM Programs:**

#### What is Institutional Quota?

The Institutional Quota (often referred to as Management Quota) is a set of seats that colleges/universities can fill at their discretion, often bypassing standard centralized admissions processes.

Typically, 15% to 30% of the total seats in private colleges or deemed universities are reserved under this category, depending on state regulations.

Students applying under the institutional quota may not be required to meet the same entrance exam cutoffs as regular admission candidates but are often required to fulfill basic eligibility criteria.

Admission through institutional quotas often involves higher fees than standard seats.

#### **Eligibility Criteria for Institutional Quota:**

Candidates must have completed a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university, usually with at least 50% marks (45% for reserved categories).

While CAT, MAT, XAT, CMAT, or GMAT scores may not be mandatory for institutional quota admissions, many institutions still prefer students who have attempted these exams.

Some colleges may require candidates to pass a personal interview and/or group discussion round as part of the selection process.

#### **Selection Process:**

**Direct Admission**: Many institutes allow direct admission under the institutional quota. The process generally involves submitting an application directly to the institute, followed by a review based on academic background, professional experience, and other criteria.

Interview/Group Discussion: Some institutes conduct interviews, case studies, or group discussions to assess the communication skills and aptitude of students applying under the institutional quota.

Entrance Exam: Although the cutoffs are lower, some institutes still consider national or state-level entrance exams like CAT, MAT, or CMAT when evaluating candidates for institutional quota seats.





#### Fee Structure:

Fees for students admitted under the institutional quota are generally **higher** than the fees for students admitted through regular merit-based processes. The difference in fees can range significantly depending on the institution.

Management Quota Fees: Many private institutions charge additional fees for management or institutional quota seats. These fees can range from INR 5 lakhs to INR 25 lakhs or more, depending on the reputation and ranking of the institution.

Payment of Capitation Fee: Some institutions may require a capitation fee (a one-time, lump-sum payment in addition to the regular course fees) for admissions under this quota.

#### **Institutes Offering Institutional Quota:**

Most private universities and autonomous institutes (like NMIMS, Symbiosis, Amity, etc.) offer institutional quota seats. Many state-affiliated private MBA colleges also offer this option.

Deemed universities often have a higher percentage of seats allocated under the management or institutional quota.

AICTE-approved institutions that offer PGDM programs are also known to allocate some seats under the management or institutional quota.

### **Application Process:**

Candidates must approach the desired institution directly, either by visiting their website or contacting the admissions office.

The application process might include submitting academic documents, entrance exam scores (if applicable), personal details, and fee payment.

Some institutions release specific forms or notifications for students interested in institutional quota seats.

#### **Entrance Exams and Institutional Quota:**

Although institutional quota seats allow for **lower entrance exam scores** compared to the general merit category, many top B-schools in India still consider national-level management entrance exams for a holistic selection.

**CAT (Common Admission Test)**: While CAT is primarily for regular seats, some institutes may offer institutional quota seats to students with moderate CAT scores.

MAT (Management Aptitude Test): Many private and deemed universities use MAT scores for institutional quota seats.
